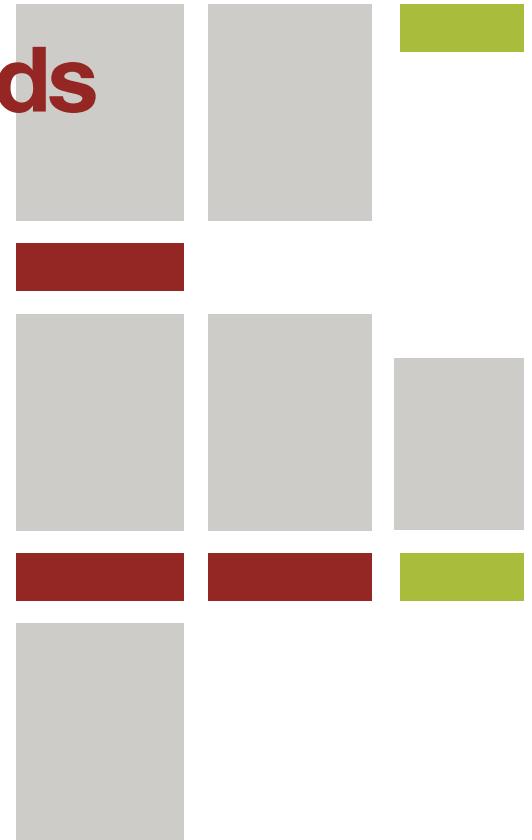
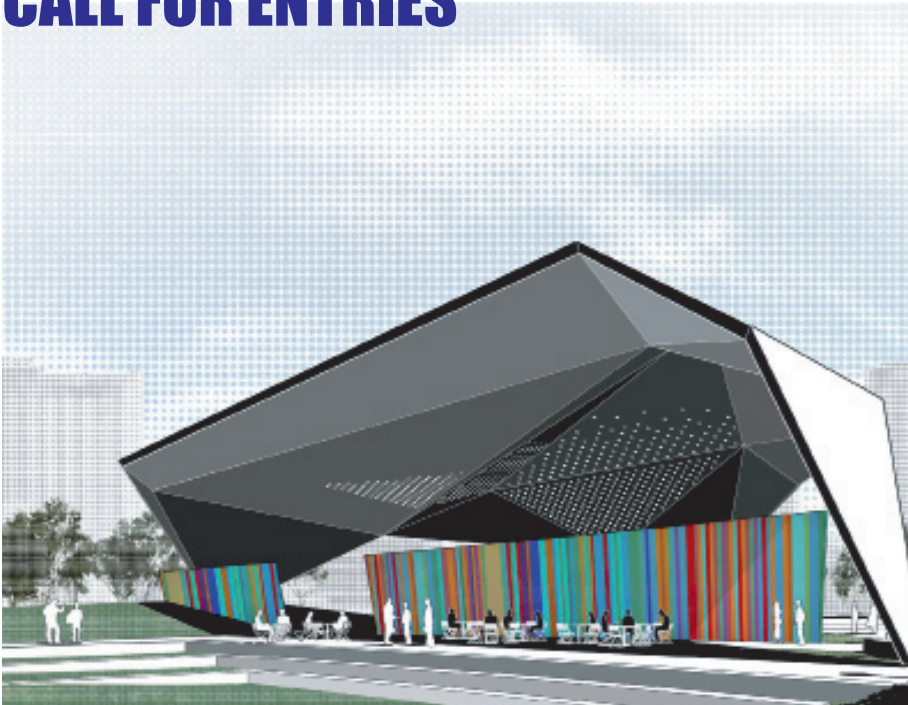
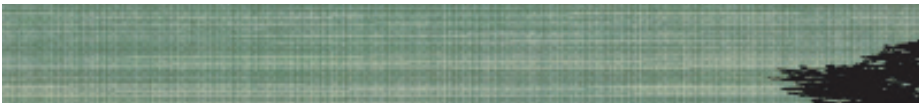


# 2012 AIA Nevada Unbuilt Design Awards CALL FOR ENTRIES



A juried program for theoretical, academic and unbuilt architecture



The AIA Nevada Unbuilt Design Awards Program is specifically designed to recognize imagination, ingenuity, resourcefulness and vision where the projects are not necessarily required to conform to the realities of constructed work. In this program jurors consider projects that have been created in the following categories over the last five years.

**Theoretical Projects** – or work that is done as an exercise in design or simply for the pleasure of creating.

**Academic Projects** –that are done as a part of a studio or for academic credit in a class program.

**And Unbuilt Projects** – this is work that has been commissioned but has not been built, and may never be built.

Through these categories we explore the architectural ideas and innovations of creative minds in finding solutions to design problems.

The **Nevada Unbuilt Design Awards Program** is provided as a part of the AIA's annual Architecture Week Celebration. Award recipients will be announced at the Architecture Week Celebration on Wednesday, April 18th– Historic Fifth Street School Auditorium – 5:30PM. ## SUBMITTAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete Entry Form and deliver to AIA Las Vegas office, along with payment for each entry, before 5pm on Thursday, March 15, 2012.
  - Submittal Fee: \$100 per entry for members - \$150 for non-members
  - Student Submittals: \$25 per entry (Students must be currently enrolled in an accredited architecture program)
  - Enter and pay by fax 702.895.4417
  - Enter and pay by mail or in person at AIA Las Vegas, 401 S. 4th Street, Suite 175, Las Vegas, NV 89101 (please call first)
2. Deliver a Project Board using images of project on a standard 24" x 36" foamcore by 5PM Monday, April 2nd, 2012.
  - Vertical or horizontal orientation
  - Minimum of two images / maximum of six images
  - Name of project on the front of the board (Project authorship **not** to be listed on front of board)
  - A simple statement on the front of your board describing the project
  - No text on the board may be smaller than 10-point type
  - Author of project's name and contact information on back of the board
3. Email a file containing a pdf of the file used to print your Project Board to Debi Raffi at [draffi@aianevada.org](mailto:draffi@aianevada.org) no later than 5PM Monday, April 2nd, 2012. The pdf file should be between 5 to 10 MB.
